

WATER MANAGEMENT AND WASTEWATER POLICY



Our hotel has a water management and wastewater policy in place. Our policy includes regular measurement, monitoring, and reduction of water consumption. The water risk situation in the areas where our hotels are located has been determined using the Water Risk Atlas. In the risk analysis, water risk has been assessed separately, and a water management plan has been developed. This plan includes goals and reporting for measuring and reducing water consumption. Due to our hotel's water usage activities, aquatic life in seas, lakes, and similar bodies of water is not harmed. However, the possibility of harm to these creatures has been assessed in the risk analysis, and necessary measures have been taken.

Our hotels comply with all legal requirements and regulations regarding water usage. The water comes from a legal and sustainable source. We measure our water consumption, calculating and reporting the total water used per guest or per stay. We have targets for reducing water consumption and plan and implement corrective measures accordingly. Water-saving equipment is used in our hotels, and good practices such as changing sheets and towels based on guest requests are implemented.

We educate and guide our employees and stakeholders on water conservation practices. We strive to ensure that wastewater does not harm the environment, complying with the regulations set by local authorities for wastewater disposal. We adhere to all legal requirements in this regard.
